

MISSION OF THE MONTH FOR APRIL

Our mission of the month is the Summer Migrant Education Program. The goal of the summer Migrant Education Program is to help bridge the education gap that our migrant students face when they move between here and Texas throughout the school year. We provide additional learning opportunities for students K-12 to ensure they are not penalized for their unique learning situation. We do this through a combination of classroom instruction (math, reading, writing, and other key academic skills) and hand-on activities, such as arts and crafts projects as well as trips to our local state parks. Molly McDonald is joining the program this year as a part-time art instructor and co-coordinator; she has a vision of having students put on an art show at the end of the program (potentially at the library) to showcase what they've learned. Funds donated will go towards art supplies, other school supplies, and essentials that we distribute to students throughout the program.


