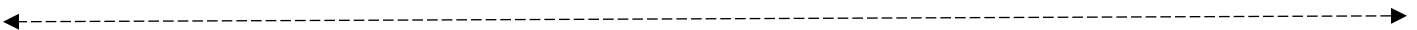

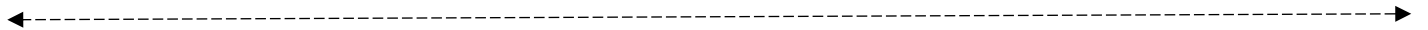
PRAY FOR COMMUNITY PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH
