Mission of the Month for January: The Heifer Project

With **Heifer International** - Your donation provides hope, security, and a future for families. Give now to multiply your gift 5x your impact. **Heifer International** is on a mission to end hunger and poverty for good. Join the fight!

Heifer International provides milk producing cows, goats, pigs, bees, and chickens to impoverished families across the world. These livestock provide food for the families, and offspring of the farm animals continue to provide future food security.

The **Heifer Project** is a global nonprofit organization founded in 1944 by Dan West. Its mission is to end hunger and poverty through sustainable, community-based agricultural development.

The organization provides livestock, agricultural training and business and community development support. The idea is to help families build long-term self-sufficiency, not just receive short-term aid. A core principle is "Passing on the Gift," where each participating family passes on the first female offspring of their animal to another family---creating a multiplying effect of support.

Heifer Project works globally, partnering with rural communities to improve food security, increase income, strengthen local economies, and promote sustainable farming practices.




CHOIR SCHEDULE: *Choir has resumed!*
