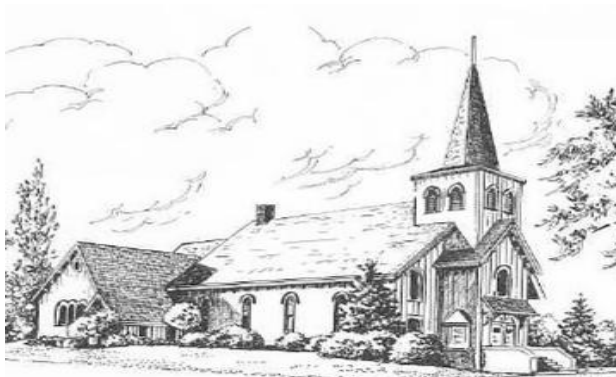

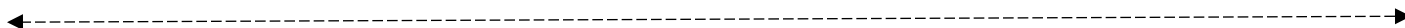

Mission of the Month for August: Amani YaJuu Mission

Our mission of the month is the Amani YaJuu mission in Kenya, Africa. 30 years ago, Amani was established to walk alongside women, mothers, and sisters, many of them refugees, on this difficult journey, marred by injustice and abuse. Amani came into existence to give women an opportunity to rebuild their lives, pass on skills and values for a better future for their children. Amani is simply about humanity finding God in the peace He gives.

This is the mission where Bonnie Bosma has gone to teach longarm quilting several times. They have many areas that the women work such as stitches, quilters, dyers, office help, organizers of products and orders. The people of the mission are very faith filled and share daily devotions with each other. They also have a children's program where they invite children from different countries to join together and learn to get along and also learn about God.

Sermon Series: Fruitful Stewards

God has entrusted CPC with many treasures: faithful people, a rich history, spiritual gifts, a church building, financial resources, and opportunities to serve our neighbors.
